Performances are an integral part of our chorus class. The performance experience is essential for students to showcase their work to an audience after several months of rehearsals. Students are required to attend all concerts of the choral group in which they are participating **and** to follow the concert dress code. Students may only miss concerts in emergency situations or if they provide a written excuse prior to the concert that is deemed acceptable by myself. Being absent from a concert due to other family events, even with a written excuse, is usually not accepted. <u>Concert Dress Code</u> (unless stated otherwise by Mrs. Aridgides)

Ladies are expected to wear:

-solid white, long/short sleeve dress shirt (no t-shirts, **tank tops**, or patterned shirts) -black or navy dress pants or black skirt (must be knee length or longer) -dark dress shoes, preferably black

Gentlemen are expected to wear:

-solid white, long/short sleeve dress shirt and tie

-black or navy dress pants and dark dress shoes, preferably black

Extra Ensemble Options:

Select Chorus is a small audition-only performing group comprising 6th, 7th, and 8th grade chorus students. In this ensemble, students perform challenging repertoire at a fast pace. Mr. Stone and I seek musically inclined students who are serious about developing their singing skills beyond chorus rehearsals in an after school setting. These students should be prepared for a full-year commitment of weekly rehearsals and a few concerts throughout the year. Find audition information on our website!

Coffee House performances occur twice per year. Students who are interested in performing a song/piece by themselves or in a small group should participate in auditions. Musical repertoire/style options will be discussed in the fall. Find more information on our website!

A Cappella is a vocal ensemble open to 7th / 8th grade chorus students who are interested in performing multi part pop music. The ensemble meets weekly during Coffee House season and performs at each Coffee House.

Drum Circle is a percussion ensemble open to all Higgins students who are interested in performing traditional drumming music from various countries. The ensemble meets (to be announced) and performs at our winter and spring concerts. Find more information on our website!
